HOW TO USE THE DIRECTORY OF BUYERS

This **Directory of Buyers** is offered by the Idaho Department of Commerce to help businesses expand markets for goods and services. Contained in the directory are addresses, phone numbers, web sites and contacts of buying offices for large businesses and state and federal agencies in Idaho and around the country. Most contacts are either buyers or small business specialists responsible for helping companies do business with their agency or firm.

Many government agencies and large businesses require potential vendors to complete vendor registration packets, which can be obtained by calling or writing contacts listed in the directory. Once you register as a vendor, obtain the name of the buyer that purchases your company's products or services. Most buyers are assigned to procure specific categories of goods or services. For example, one buyer may purchase computer equipment while another buyer, within the organization, is responsible for purchasing aircraft components.

Often the individual buyers maintain their own bidders' list for vendors that can supply the commodities they procure. To be included on the list, call or write the buyer handling the products or services you sell, advising him or her of your interest and furnishing information regarding your firm's qualifications. Then follow-up periodically with that buyer as you would with any potential customer.

Price is often a primary consideration in contract award. But other factors such as quality, past performance and delivery schedules that may be of equal or greater importance in determining the award of a contract.

The aggressive and responsive business will usually make the sale.

The Directory of Buyers is only one of many services offered to Idaho businesses through the Idaho

Procurement Technical Assistance Center (PTAC). Other services include:

- Customized federal and state bidding opportunities, delivered by e-mail or conventional mail;
- "How To" marketing assistance for selling to government agencies and large prime contractors;
- Access to the Military and Federal Standards and Specifications supplied, upon request;
- One-on-one procurement technical assistance;
- Federal Acquisition Regulations (FAR), interpretation and assistance;
- Electronic commerce market research and technical assistance;
- Central Contractor Registration (CCR) assistance and On-line Representations and Certifications assistance (ORCA);
- Bid document interpretation and assistance, market research including procurement histories, buying activities, and points of contact;
- Business advocacy.

NATIONAL PARK SERVICE

The National Park Service administers three hundred plus areas in the System. There are three principal categories used in classification: natural areas, historical areas, and recreational areas. The National Parks are used by approximately 250 million visitors annually, which makes a significant contribution to the economy of the Nation. From this enormous visitation, most benefits go to business in the form of food, lodging, and travel expenditures. Many other benefits, however, are passed on to the local or national firms by way of services or supplies actually required to operate and maintain the National Park System.

The National Park Service expends approximately \$200 million annually for goods and services acquired under contract. Over 90 percent of these dollars go to small

businesses. The majority of the procurement dollars are spent in the area of construction. The remainder is spent for automated data processing, hardware, software and services, maintenance services, professional services including architect and engineering services, heavy equipment and various other supply-type items.
